    SEPs/EUSIFs




# LGA "rewiring...local growth", June 2013

- Four major propositions
  - Local treasury (now rebadged 'place-based financing')
  - 'Growth pacts' rather than transactional bilateral deals
  - Greater involvement of key players locally (e.g. HEIs, employers etc)
  - Horizontal integration and simplification (cf to vertical silos)

























